Dear WTSD Family:

I hope this letter finds you well. You are receiving this letter because your son / daughter is enrolled in the School Aged Child Care program (SACC). For years, the SACC program has been an asset to our community, affording parents peace of mind knowing their children are safe and well-cared for while they are at work.

As most of you are aware, the Board of Education has contracted with Inquiring Minds (IQ) to operate and manage the SACC program for the 2016-17 school year. Although IQ is overseeing our program, we have implemented a few changes based on your comments and suggestions. Our goal is to provide a program that offers the most benefits for you and your family. One of the significant changes was to provide before and after-school care in one central location, thus alleviating the need for parents to travel from building to building at the beginning or end of the work day.

However, due to an increased number of student enrollments and to be considerate of your travel time, **we will be moving the program to Waterford Elementary School starting Monday, October 3rd.** The hours will remain the same, and a shuttle bus will transport students to both the Atco and Thomas Richards Elementary Schools.

I understand that making a change like this may be difficult with only one month in, but WES will not only offer more space (in fact, at least 3 times the space), it will also offer those students who wish to participate in clubs and/or tutoring an opportunity to do so. As in years past, we do not have a shuttle available to pick up students for clubs or tutoring. However, please know we are trying to find an amicable solution that will benefit those students and not cause a cost increase to parents of clubs or the district.
